* 6.9.8 and 6.9.9 has some changes to the TLS version used, these changes have gone in to 6.9.8 and 6.9.9 after the final QA stage of 7.0. This means that upgrade to 7.0 from 6.9.8 and 6.9.9 is not possible without manual intervention. A 7.0.1 version has been released which will allow upgrade from 6.9.8 and 6.9.9. All versions in the above table prior to version 7.0 are branded as HDID.

Downgrades are NOT supported

Due to the company name change from Hitachi Data Systems to Hitachi Vantara we have had to change the certificate used to sign the binary files which make up the Protector install. The existing HDS certificate has now expired and this means the Protector master will not push upgrade its clients. HDID 6.7.7 is the first release which can resolve the issue. However, this means that in order to be able to push upgrade, Windows nodes need to be manually installed with HDID 6.7.7 via the supported upgrade paths. It is still possible to push upgrade non-Windows nodes. See HDID-EN-007 for more information

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
